- Interventional Radiology Fellowship or equivalent experience
- Mon-Fri 8-4:30
- 50% Interventional/50% Diagnostic
- Modalities: CT, MR, X-ray, US, Mammography, PET imaging/CT-PET fusion, Nuclear Medicine
