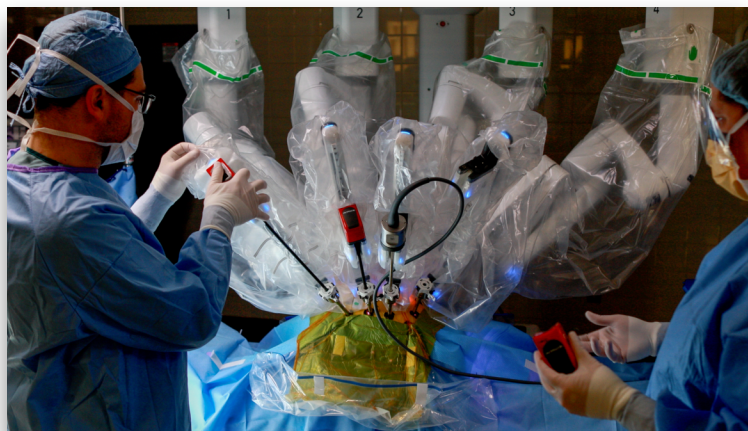

# THE IMPACT OF GRANTS

2021 saw the creation of a cooperative grants program between the CHMC Foundation, CHMC, and Carthage Area Hospital. Grant funding allowed us to create and launch a new Community Wellness program, \$25 Feeds Five, while supporting existing vital Diabetes Education classes.

We were able to support the Children's Mental Health Unit, creating an endowment for future needs and assisting with education and activity programming. We also support the ongoing patient nutrition and care kit program at the REW CTC.
